Dir Jacob said the loading dock is in bad shape, they were hoping to wait for the expansion next year to repair it, but it can't wait. There are other projects that have been passed by council and they are hoping to group them all together to get a good price and they need to do this asap. Needs to pass as emergency.

3. The matter of applying for an Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant. [this will also go to Finance Mtg on 10/15/24] Referred By: Parks & Rec Dir Reardon

Dir Reardon said this is an ODNR Grant. They would like to completely redo the playground at West Park. This is east of the rec center by ballfield number one, as you come into the park off of Foster. This is part pf the Master Plan. The current one is 27 years old and time for a new one. It will be a fully accessible ADA playground. The price estimates are around \$650,000 for the whole project. Includes ground work and drainage and the poured surface and the equipment itself. This is a one to one matching grant and the same grant that was used for the trail and restroom.

This grant also paid for the pickle ball courts. They will also use CDBG money for this which will bring the City's portion down. They would be looking at \$325,000 that would be the ask for this grant. The rest would be between CDBG funds and Issue 6 Funds. The deadline is November 15th and it needs to be passed as emergency.

Motion made by Mr. Stewart second by Mr. Armstrong to authorize the Mayor to apply for the 'said' grant to be used for the playground project at West Park.
